1. Who is eligible to apply for JESP 2017 sponsorship?

- SPM/O-Levels 2016 leavers
- STPM 2016 leavers
- Pre-University Program 2016 leavers, such as A-Levels, IB, Asasi and Matriculation

2. What are the minimum requirements to apply?

a. Academic qualification for 2016:

SPM/O-Levels 8A **STPM** 4A

A-Levels Grade 'A' for all subjects

International Baccalaureate (IB) 37 points Other Pre-University programs (eq. Matriculation, Asasi, etc) CGPA 3.50

Minimum of 8As in Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) is inclusive 6 compulsory subjects as per table below:

3. I am interested. How do I apply and what are the necessary supporting documents?

Pre-application:

- 1. Submit a copy of examination result transcript, co-curriculum certificates and candidate's NRIC to **jesp@jcorp.com.my.**
- 2. Attach a copy of offer letter from universities to **jesp@jcorp.com.my (if available)**
- 3. The purpose of pre-application is to check for minimum requirement needed to apply.

Assesment Centre JESP 2017

- 1. Application that meets the requirement shall be short-listed to sit for online assesment. The successful applicant shall be notified through email.
- 2. Candidates that are selected for the assessment centre JESP 2017 will be notified in April. If you do not receive any response by 1st April 2017, you may consider your application to be unsuccessful. Any phone calls pertaining to application status shall not be entertained.
- **3.** Once shortlisted, you will undergo JESP Assessment Centre consist of Group Dynamics and Individual Interview Session.
- **4.** The result of the assesment centre shall be sent through email. All communication shall be made via e-mail only. Please make sure that your e-mail is active and not a spam.

8. Do I have to attend any tests or interviews?

Yes. Once shortlisted, you will be undergoing our JESP Assessment Centre which consists of three (3) stages as below:

- Group dynamics/Case study Assessment
- Interview with JCorp panel

9. When and how will the applicants be notified about their application status?
