General Terms and Conditions

1. Possess strong leadership skills and active participation in extra-curricular, social or voluntary activities
2. Applicants must have a consistent and outstanding academic achievement record as follows:

Undergraduate (Bachelor's Degree)

1. Obtained admission to pursue studies or currently in the first year of a Bachelor's Degree programme at renowned selected universities in Malaysia (Conditional offer can be considered)
2. Obtained a minimum of 3As and 1B for STPM or GCE A-Levels or a minimum CGPA 3.50 / 4.00 for Pre-University or Diploma or Foundation or Matriculation Programme
3. Not exceeding 21 years of age as at the enrolment date for the Bachelor's Degree programme
4. A personal statement is required (Title: Why Khazanah Nasional Scholarship is for you and how you can contribute to the good governance practice and leadership development of Malaysia)

Master's Degree

1. Obtained admission to pursue studies at renowned selected universities in Malaysia (Conditional offer can be considered)
2. Obtained a minimum of Second Class Upper Division (UK and Australia University) or where there is a point system, obtained a minimum CGPA of 3.50 for Bachelor's Degree
3. Not exceeding 40 years of age as at the enrolment date for the Master's degree
4. A personal statement (Title: Why Khazanah Nasional Scholarship is for you and how you can contribute to the good governance practice and leadership development of Malaysia) and research outline/ thesis summary are required

Ph.D

1. Obtained admission to pursue studies or currently in the first year of a Doctoral Degree programme at renowned selected universities in Malaysia. (Conditional offer can be considered)
2. Obtained a Master Degree with a distinction or a minimum CGPA 3.50 / 4.00 or 'A' grade average and/or excellent examiners' report if the Master Degree is by research
3. Obtained a minimum of Second Class Upper Division (UK and Australia University) or where there is a point system, obtained a minimum CGPA of 3.50 for Bachelor's Degree
4. Not exceeding 40 years of age as at the enrolment date for the Doctorate programme
5. A personal statement (Title: Why Khazanah Nasional Scholarship is for you and how you can contribute to the good governance practice and leadership development of Malaysia) and research outline/ thesis summary are required

5. For postgraduate (research or mixed mode), you are required to upload your research outline or thesis summary to complete your online application.
6. **You are not allowed to apply for more than one scholarship programme in every cycle. Yayasan Khazanah has the right to not accept applications if the same applicant applies for more than one programme.**
7. All applications must be completed before submission. **Required documents** must be attached for further processing.
